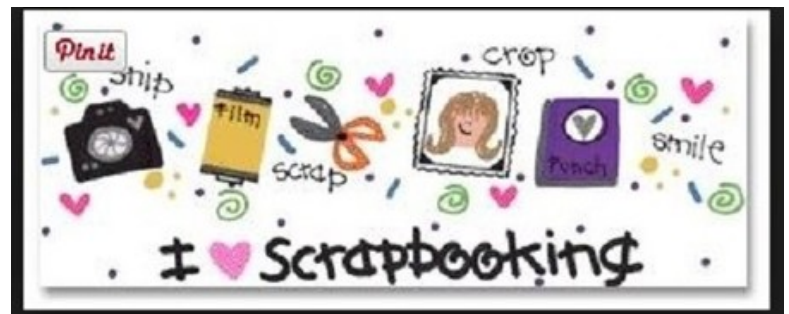

Armchair Astronomy: Looking Back to the Big Bang

The James Webb Telescope is intended to look back to 13 billion years ago, nearly to the 13.8 billion year ago Big Bang. It was launched on 25 Dec 2021, reached its orbiting point around Lagrange Point 2 in February, and aligned the 18 hexagonal mirrors in March. 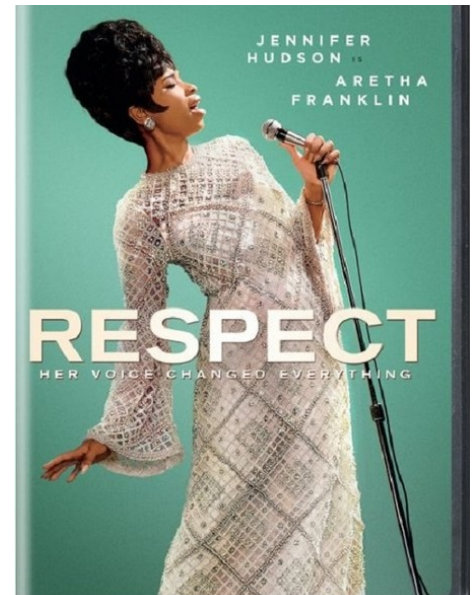

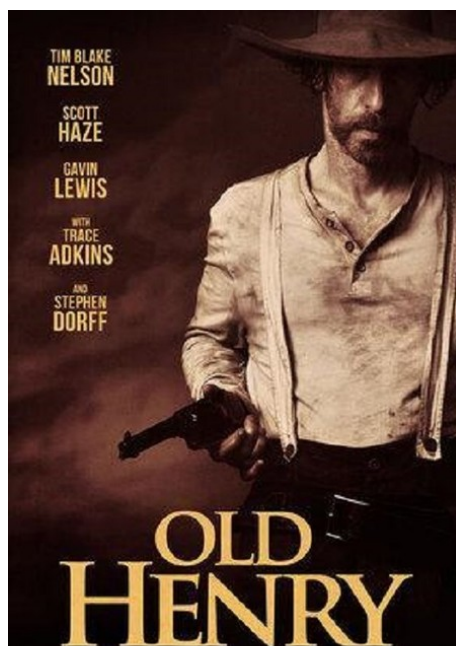
