

# *The Transfiguration of the Lord*

Celebrated August 6th, an event described in the Synoptic Gospels (Matthew 17:1–9, Mark 9:2–8, Luke 9:28–36). In 2 Peter 1:16–18 there is also a reference to it. Jesus takes Peter, James, son of Zebedee and John the Apostle with him and goes up to a mountain, which is not named. Once on the mountain, Matthew (17:2) states that Jesus "was transfigured before them; his face shining as the sun, and his garments became white as the light." At that point the prophets Elijah and Moses appear and Jesus begins to talk to them. Luke (9:32) remarks of Jesus "they saw his glory". A bright cloud appears, and a voice from the cloud is heard: "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him". The disciples then fall to the ground in fear, but Jesus approaches and touches them, telling them not to be afraid. When the disciples look up, they no longer see Elijah or Moses. When Jesus and the three apostles are going back down the mountain, Jesus tells them to not to tell anyone "the things they had seen" until the "Son of Man" has risen from the dead. The apostles are described as questioning among themselves as to what Jesus meant by "risen from the dead". In Christian teachings, the Transfiguration is a pivotal moment, and the setting on the mountain is presented as the point where human nature meets God: the meeting place for the temporal and the eternal, with Jesus himself as the connecting point, acting as the bridge between heaven and earth.

The painting on the cover of this week's bulletin is by Pietro Perugia. Originally named Pietro Vannucci, he was born sometime around 1450 to a wealthy family in Città della Pieve, Umbria. He became known as Pietro Perugia by being associated with the chief city of Umbria, named Perugia. We do not know about his initial training, but he apprenticed in the workshop of Andrea del Verrocchio alongside Leonardo da Vinci, and other famous artists. Upon the completion of his training he was enrolled as a painter in the confraternity of St. Luke. Later, his own students were painters Pinturicchio and Raphael, the most classic master of the High Renaissance.
