### Remember Me?

The Queen of Soul, Aretha Franklin was born on March 25, 1942, in Memphis, Tenn. Eighteen Grammy awards, 17 top 10 pop singles and 20 No. 1 R&B singles later, she's regarded as one of the greats. "Jump to It" and get to reading these fun facts about Lady Soul herself.

- Franklin was a self-taught piano player, learning notes and melodies by ear.
- At the young age of 16, she went on tour with Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.
- She first signed with Columbia Records as a pop artist in the early '60s, enjoying moderate success for several years with songs such as "Won't Be Long."
- In 1966, she transitioned to a soul label, Atlantic Records. A year later, she released "Respect," which became her signature song.
- Her song "(You Make Me Feel Like) A Natural Woman" was and still is a karaoke anthem.
- She was the first female inductee into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame, and took the top spot in Rolling Stone's list of 100 Greatest Singers of All Time in 2010.
- With over 75 million records sold globally, Franklin is one of the best-selling artists in history.
